As a candidate for Miss Princess Regatta, each contestant will be judged in (4) four categories:

- Interview (3-minute interview taken before the pageant)
- Stage Presentation and poise
- Theme wear outfit "All That Glitters is GOLD" - No cupcake dresses or cocktail dresses. This outfit should be primarily sparkly and/or sequins, but shows your personality. BE CREATIVE and HAVE FUN!
- Evening Gown (must be one piece with no midriff showing and floor length)

The contestants will also be asked a question on stage, however judging for the question will only be used in the event of a tie. Contestants will not know the question in advance.

Entrant must be born a female whose age shall not be less than 9 years old and no more than 11 years old as of June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The contestants are allowed to wear age appropriate makeup such as lip gloss and light mascara.

ALL JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

The Miss Princess Regatta Pageant will be held on Saturday, June 29 at 12:00pm at North Madison Christian Church in conjunction with the Little Miss Regatta Pageant. Interviews will begin earlier that morning. Interview times will be given out at rehearsal. Rehearsal is Friday, June 28 at 5:00pm at North Madison Christian Church. The pageant is open to the general public. No one except ONE (1) helper, contestants of the pageant, members of the Regatta and volunteers of the pageant will be allowed backstage or in the dressing rooms during rehearsal and presentation of the pageant.

The winner of the Miss Princess Regatta Pageant will receive a crown, sash, entry into the Madison Regatta parade, general admission wristband and pit pass to the Madison Regatta. The winner of the pageant should be available for all Regatta related activities during the week prior to and including the Madison Regatta race, which is held the week of June 30 thru July 7, 2019.

During her reign as Miss Princess Regatta, she will be attending many Regatta related activities and speaking with members of the press. She will be attending these functions escorted by a chairperson of the Miss Princess Regatta pageant. As she will be representing the Madison Regatta, she will be expected to dress with good taste and present a good image for the Madison Regatta. If for some reason, these requirements are not followed, she will risk forfeiture of her crown, sash and title to the first runner up. The first and second runner up may also be invited to participate in some of the Regatta festivities.
