Scholarship Rules and Regulations

The Pageant will be held on Monday July 1st 2019 at North Madison Christian Church.

Entrant agrees to abide by the rules of the Madison Regatta now in effect or as announced hereafter.

Entrant agrees that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the Madison Regatta Pageant Committee and that the decision of the judges is final.

An entrant must be single, never have been married nor had a marriage annulled, and must not get married during her year of service. She must not be or ever have been pregnant.

Entrant must be born female whose age shall not be less than eighteen (18) nor more than twenty-two (22) years on Jan. 1st of the pageant year. Entrant must provide either a copy of her birth certificate or driver's license as proof of age.

An entrant must be enrolled in high school or a high school graduate and enrolled in college by September 1st of the pageant year in which she will compete.

An entrant must be of good moral character and shall not have been convicted of any crimes and shall possess poise, personality, intelligence, charm, and the ability to speak in public. Entrants should also be aware of their social media content.

The Miss Madison Regatta Queen will compete at the Indiana State Festivals Pageant in January. The 2019 Miss Madison Regatta will be required to crown the next Miss Madison Regatta Queen in July of 2020. Failure to do so, will result in forfeiture of crown, sash, title and scholarship to the first runner up who will presume her duties.

An entrant must attend pageant and dance rehearsal on Tuesday, June 18th from 6:00-9:00pm and Thursday June 27th from 8:30-9:00pm at North Madison Christian Church.

There will be a contestant meet and greet – Date TBD.

The deadline to enter the pageant is June 16th at 6:00pm. The entry fee is \$125.00 (non-refundable)

A contestant is required to appear in four (4) clothing changes during the competition: business attire (Interview), opening number, dance attire, and evening gown.

There will be a 7-minute interview before the pageant begins. Contestants are to wear business professional attire of their choice. This will account for 40 points of the contestant's overall score.

This year's theme is "All That Glitters is GOLD". Contestants are required to wear an outfit of their choice that is GOLD for the opening number. Contestants are encouraged to show their personality. This will account for 15 points of the contestant's overall score.

Contestants will perform a dance during this year's pageant and will be provided a pageant t-shirt for this area of competition. Contestants are asked to wear black shorts and tennis shoes. This will account for 10 points of the contestant's overall score.

Evening gowns must be floor length. This will account for 20 points of the contestant's overall score.

Contestants will be asked an on-stage question during the evening gown portion of the competition and will not be given the question in advance. This will account for 15 points of the contestant's overall score.

If crowned the 2019 Miss Madison Regatta Queen, the winner must be available for the entire week of the Regatta Festival and Regatta Race Weekend. She must be available to attend all Regatta related events from July 1st – July 7th 2019. The first and second runner up may be asked to attend some Regatta related events.

Each Contestant will be allowed **ONE** (1) helper in the dressing room at all times. That helper will not be allowed to leave the dressing room during the pageant. There will be pageant volunteers and pageant committee members backstage for extra help.

There will be no cell phones allowed in the dressing room at any time during the pageant. Each contestant and the contestant's helper will be required to surrender their cell phones at the beginning of the pageant.

Contestants will be required to submit an 8x10" headshot with their application.

Each contestant must also submit a 250-word essay answering the question: "What does the Madison Regatta mean to the community?"
