2019 Miss Teen Regatta Pageant  
Ages 15-17**

As a candidate for Miss Teen Regatta, each contestant will be judged in (4) four categories:

- Interview (3-minute interview taken before the pageant)
- Stage Presentation and Poise
- Theme Wear Outfit- "All That Glitters is GOLD" – This outfit must be GOLD but shows your personality. BE CREATIVE AND FUN.
- Outfit for On-Stage Dance (Contestants will be given a pageant t-shirt and will wear white shorts and tennis shoes)
- Evening Gown (must be one piece with no midriff showing, floor length, and age appropriate)

Make-up should be age appropriate. The contestants will also be asked an on-stage question, however judging for the question will only be used in the event of a tie. Contestants will not know the question in advance. Each contestant will be required to learn a dance that will be taught prior to the pageant and performed on stage.

ALL JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

Entrant must be single and never have been married nor had a marriage annulled, and she must not be or have ever been pregnant. Entrant must be born a female whose age shall not be less than 15 years old and not older than 17 years old as of June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The Miss Teen Regatta Pageant will be held on Saturday, June 29<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm at North Madison Christian Church in conjunction with the Miss Teen Regatta Pageant. Interview times will be given out at the pageant rehearsal. Dance Practices will be on Thursday, June 27<sup>th</sup> from 6-9pm at North Madison Christian Church. Pageant and additional Dance Rehearsals will Friday, June 28<sup>th</sup> from 6:30-9pm at North Madison Christian Church. The pageant is open to the general public. No one except for **ONE (1)** helper, contestants of the pageant, members of the Regatta and volunteers of the pageant will be allowed backstage or in the dressing rooms during rehearsal and presentation of the pageant.

The winner of the Miss Teen Regatta Pageant will receive a crown, sash, and entry into the Madison Regatta parade. Furthermore, Miss Teen Regatta will receive a general admission wristband and pit pass to the Madison Regatta. The winner of the pageant should be available for all Regatta related activities during the week prior to and including the Madison Regatta Race, which is held the week of June 30<sup>th</sup> thru July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

During her reign as Miss Teen Regatta, she will be attending many Regatta related activities and speaking with members of the press. She will be attending these functions escorted by a chairperson of the Miss Teen Regatta pageant. As she will be representing the Madison Regatta, she will be expected to dress with good taste and present a good image for the Madison Regatta. If for some reason, these requirements are not followed, she will risk forfeiture of her crown, sash, and trophy to the first runner up. The first and second runner up may also be invited to participate in some of the Regatta festivities.
